

Supplementary Services

What the ITC Program can cover.

- Allied health fee gap assistance
- Radiology procedure fee gap assistance
- DAA (Dose administration aids including Webster Packing)
- Nebuliser & other asthma-related equipment (Where possible, spacers should be used rather than nebulisers)
- Mobility aids (e.g. walking frames, or non-electric wheel chairs) or shower chairs.
- Specialist fee gap assistance
- Transport subsidy (including parking fees and cab vouchers)
- CPAP equipment
- Orthotics & footwear
- Glucometer & diabetes-related equipment
- Spectacles

What the ITC Program cannot cover:

- Costs incurred by clients prior to being referred to and enrolled into the ITC Program.
- Surgery in acute or sub-acute settings. Use of Supplementary Services funding is restricted to funding primary care follow-up services.
- Dental costs
- Any treatments or procedures that occur in a hospital (public or private)
- Medication costs

Reminder:

The Integrated Team Care Program cannot fund supplementary services that are not specified in the GPMP / TCA / Care Plan.
